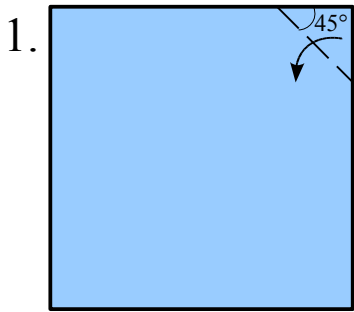


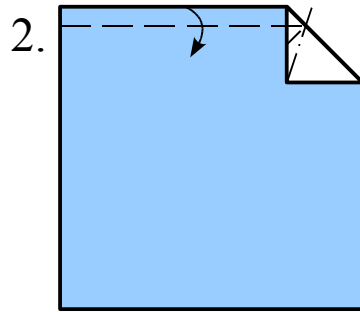

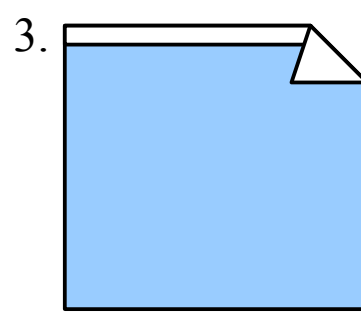
Recommended Paper: kami (thin with contrasting front and back).



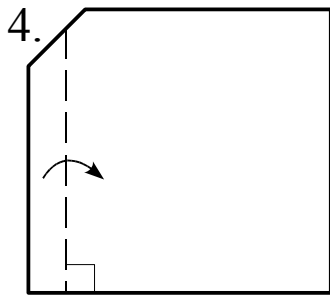
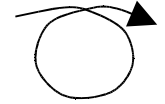
1. RAT dog-ear (45°).



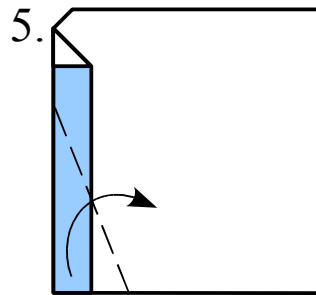
2. Swivel some paper to the inside.



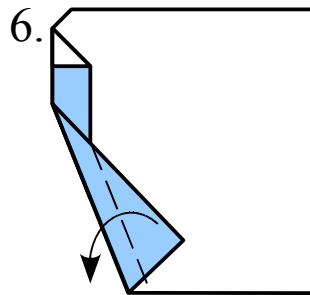
3. Swivel some paper to the inside.



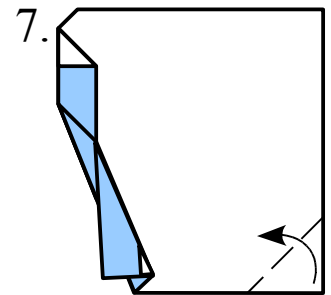
4. Perpendicular RAT fold.



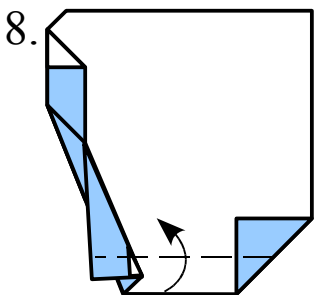

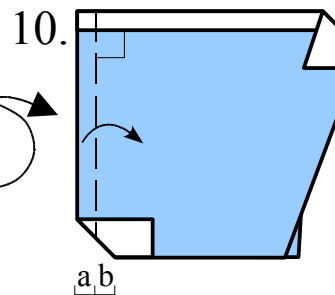
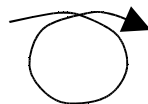
7. RAT dog-ear (45°).



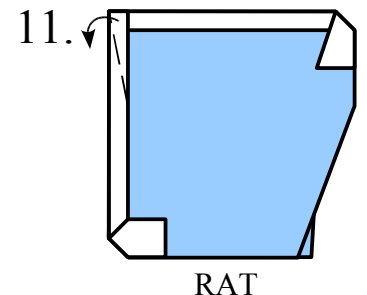

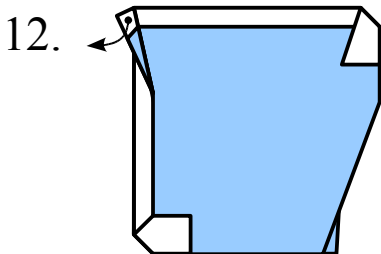

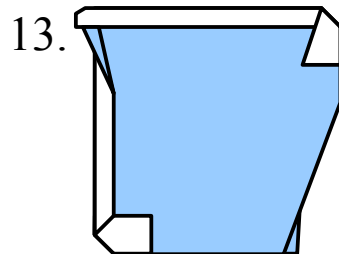
10. Perpendicular RAT, $a \approx b$.
