
"Un-inside-reverse" to release one layer of paper to form the crest. A toothpick or burnishing tool can reach into the narrow space and release the paper all the way to the tip of the beak.




Inside-reverse the neck and tail, again as with an unmodified traditional crane.



Fold the wings down and crease moderately sharply so that they will remain more horizontal after inflating the crane. Raise the wings back to 90° .



Inside-reverse to form the head.
