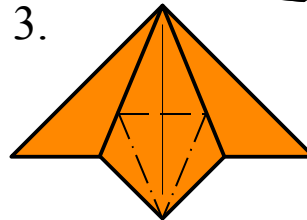
Recommended Paper: thin 3" - 6"  
 (75mm - 150mm) square.



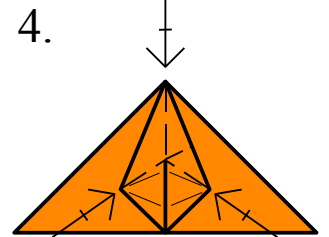
Fold a colorful waterbomb base.



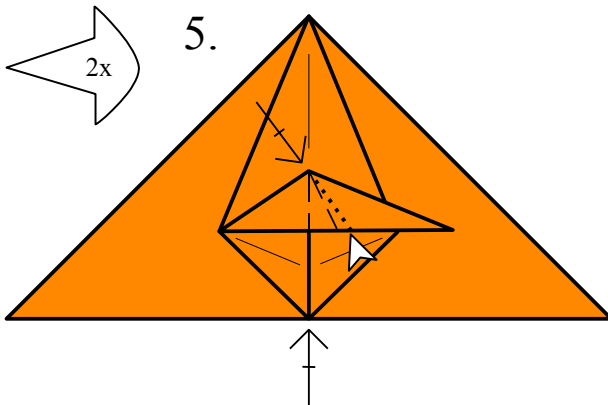
Squash. Repeat behind with the opposite flap.



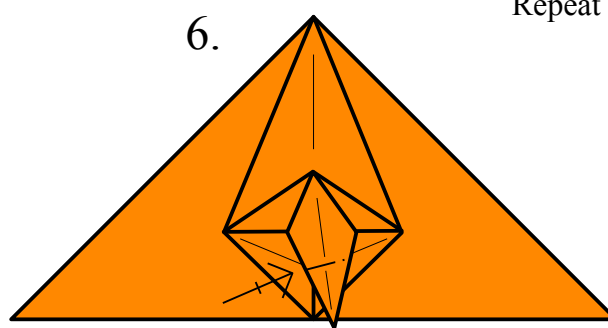
Petal fold. Repeat behind.



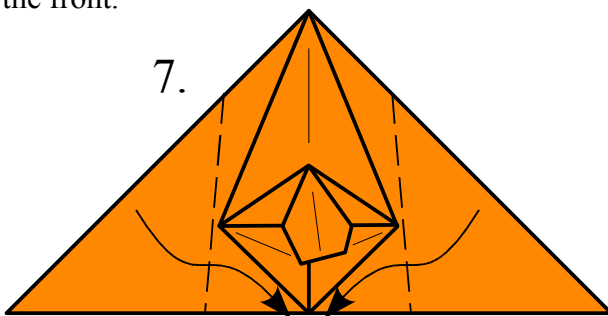
Rabbit-ear. Each pre-crease starts at one of the wide side corners of the kite shape, while the descending edge crosses the opposite corner. Repeat behind.



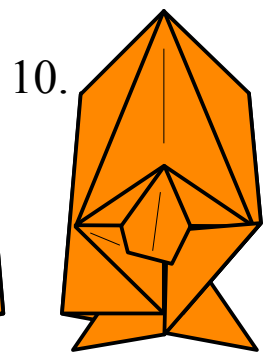
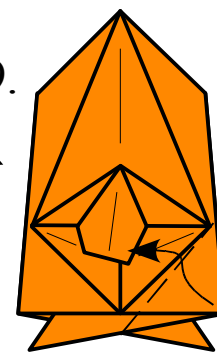
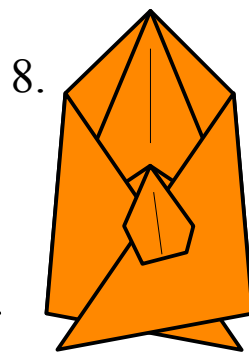
Slightly asymmetric squash. The tip should slightly exceed the bottom edge. Repeat behind. Align with the front.



Shape the pectoral fin. Repeat behind.



Shape the midsection of the fish. Folds are nearly parallel to the center line, tilted slightly in towards the head. Side edges come in under the fin as far as possible.



Bring the other side of the tail to the front.
