Recommended Paper: very thin two-sided $6 "(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ square or larger. If only white paper is available, color one corner on the front of the paper.

## Variation 1

In the standard version, the heart is the only color on the outside, but there is a loose corner. This variation trades the loose corner for a small colorful square on the back. This variation can also hold something small and flat inside.

The shaded area will become the heart; write on the rest of the colorful side.

The shaded area will show on the outside; write on the rest of the colorful side.


The shaded areas will show on the outside; write on the rest of the white side.

Where to write? For the standard version, all but one little colorful corner is hidden, so it is clear: write on the colorful side, but not on the corner that will be the heart. The first variation is also mostly white, but there is a colorful square in back. This paper comes from the same corner, so write on the colorful side, but give the corner which will be the heart a little wider berth. Variation 2 shows more color. Only a hem of white shows, so write on the white side, but leave a margin on the sides which will be adjacent to the heart. The crease maps show this visually.
