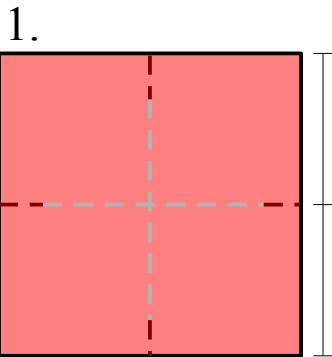


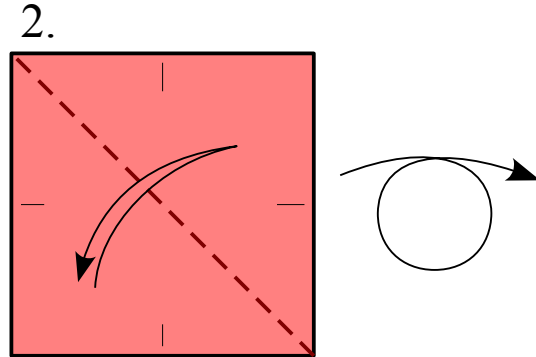
Heart Swan

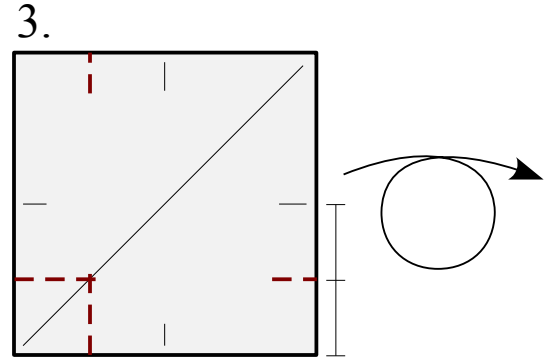
Recommended Paper: very thin two-sided 6" (15cm) square or larger.



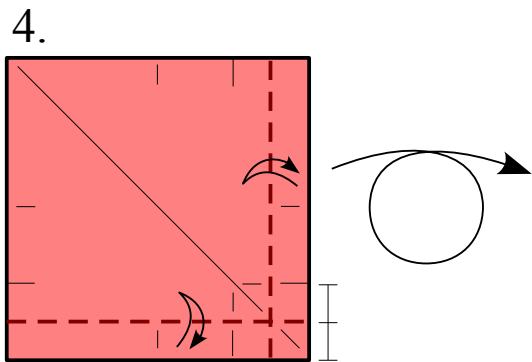

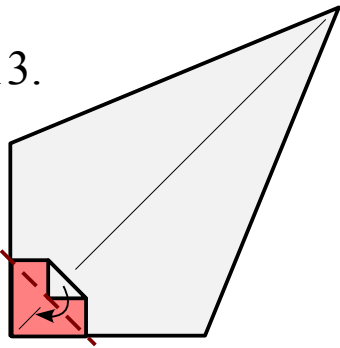
The next few steps can be accomplished by a good eye estimating the center and deft fingers, but adding this fold is easier.
