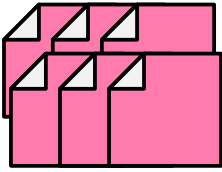


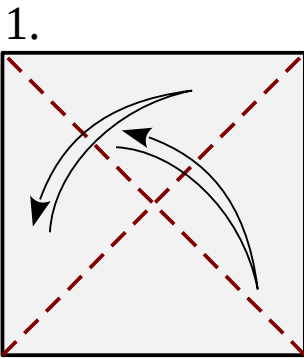
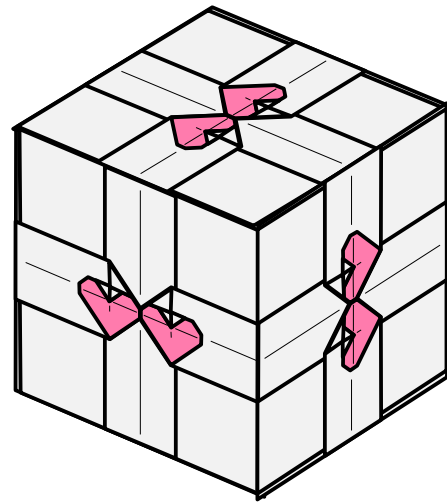
Heart To Heart Cube and Topsy Turvy Heart Cube

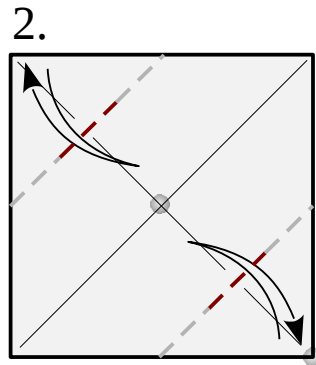

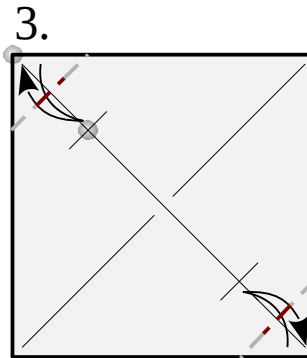

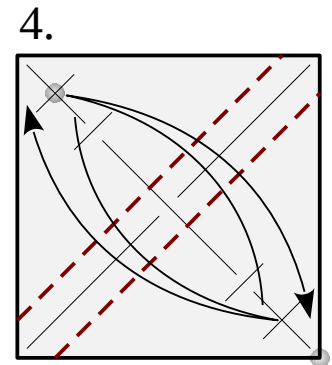
Fold and unfold.



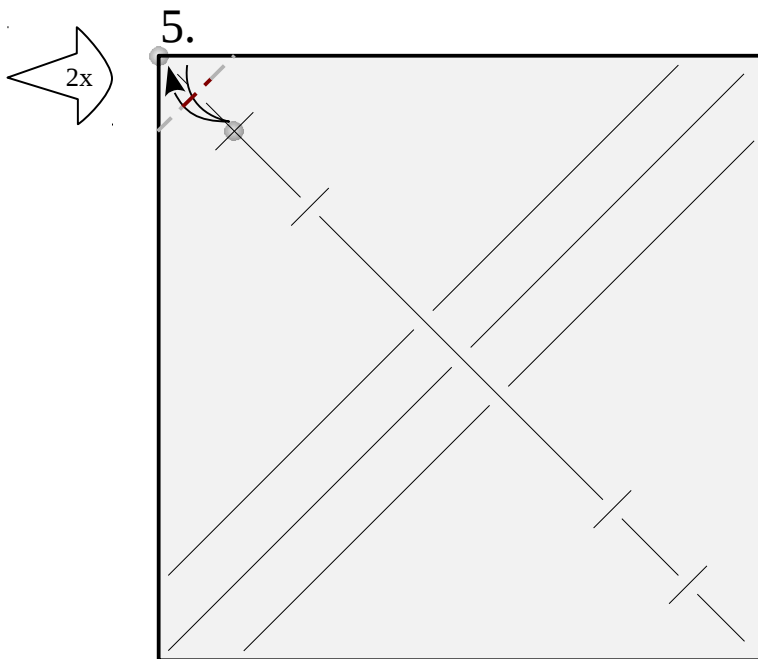
Bring the two (2) corners

across the diagonal.



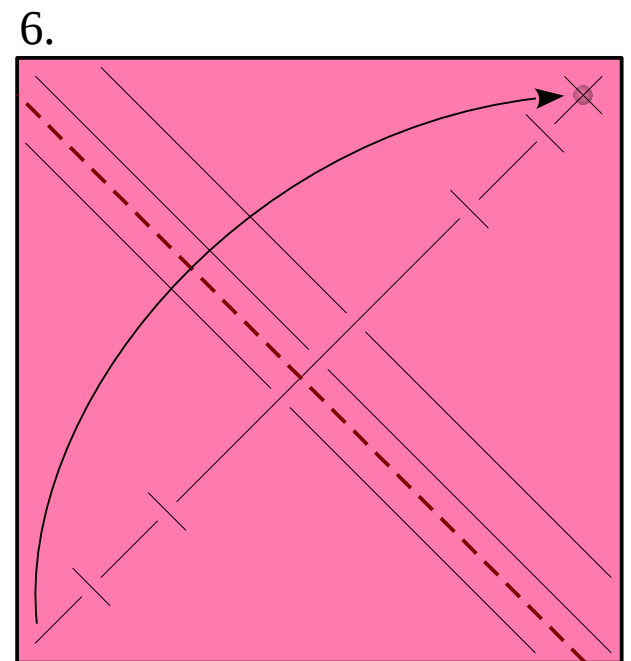
Bring the corners to the

pinch across the diagonal.



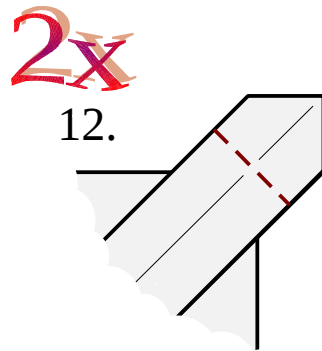
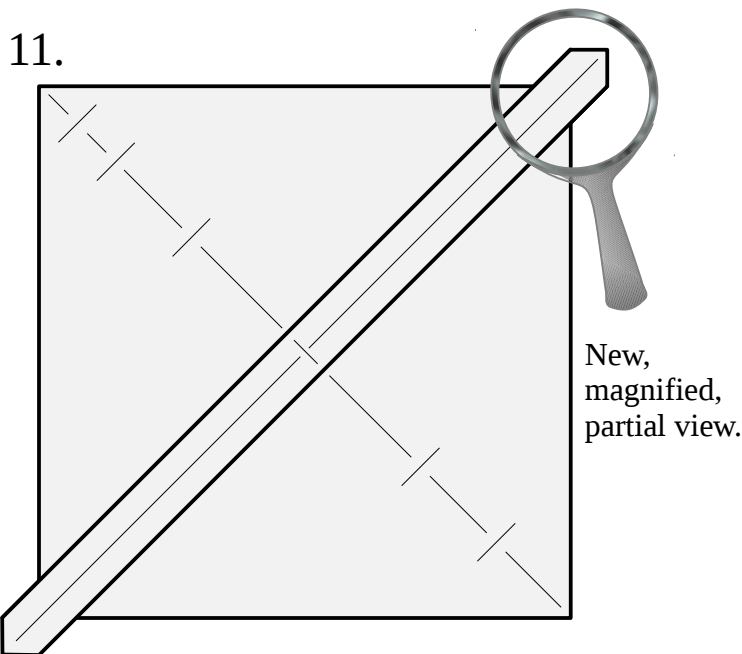
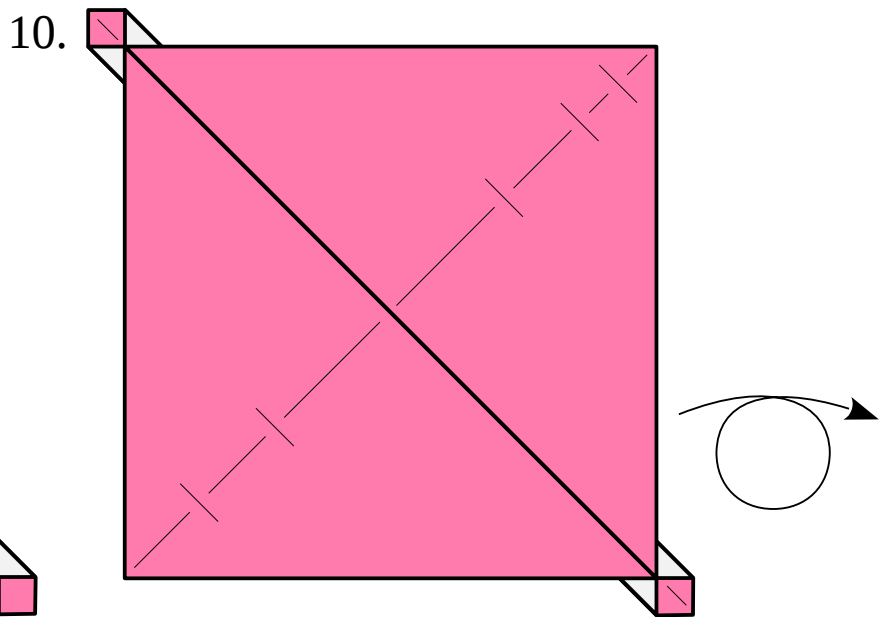
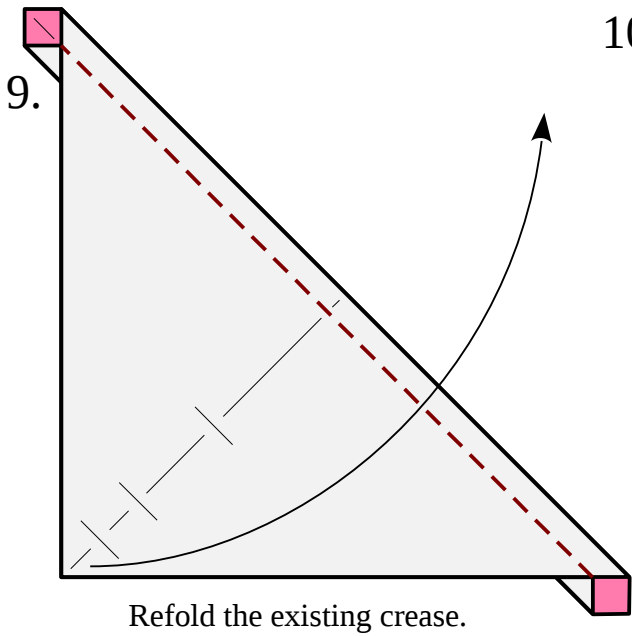
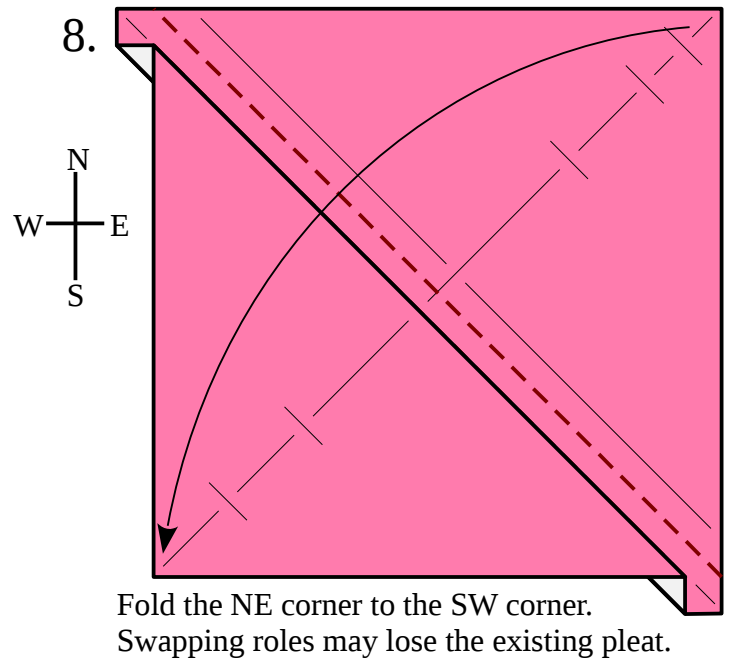
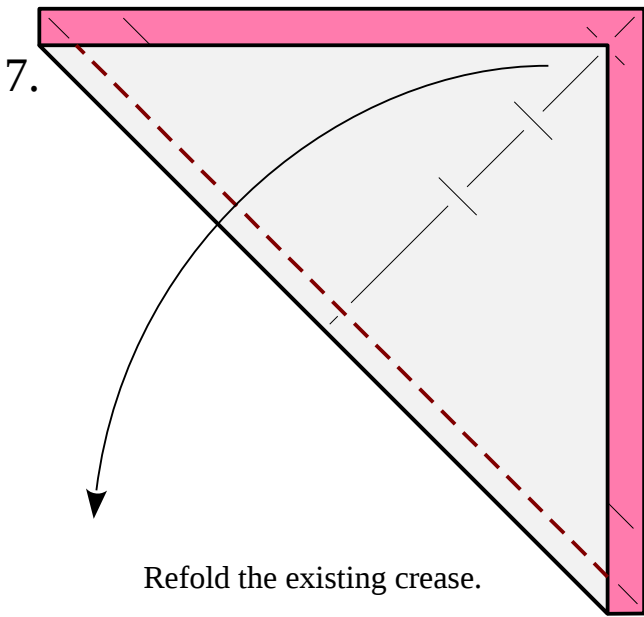
Fold each of the two (2)

pinch marks and unfold.



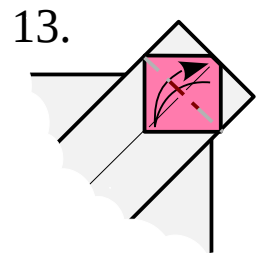
Bring one (1) corner to the nearest pinch
for a new pinch across the diagonal.



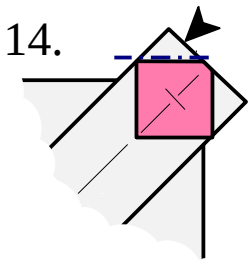
Fold the furthest corner to the new pinch mark.



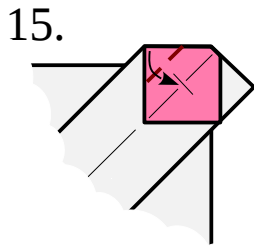
Fold back, nipping off the corner of the colorful square from the other side. This rounds one side of the nascent heart. Repeat on the other, similar corner.



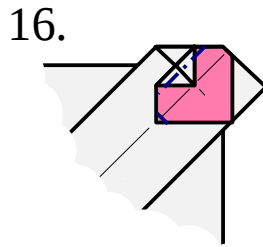
Pinch the center of the colorful square by bringing the raw edges to the color-change lines, since the corner is in back. Repeat on the similar corner



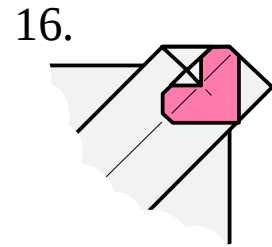
Inside-reverse fold along the color-change line. Repeat on the other heart, keeping an eye on the symmetry. Use corners the same side of the bar for hearts the same way up.



Repeat on the other heart.

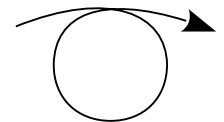
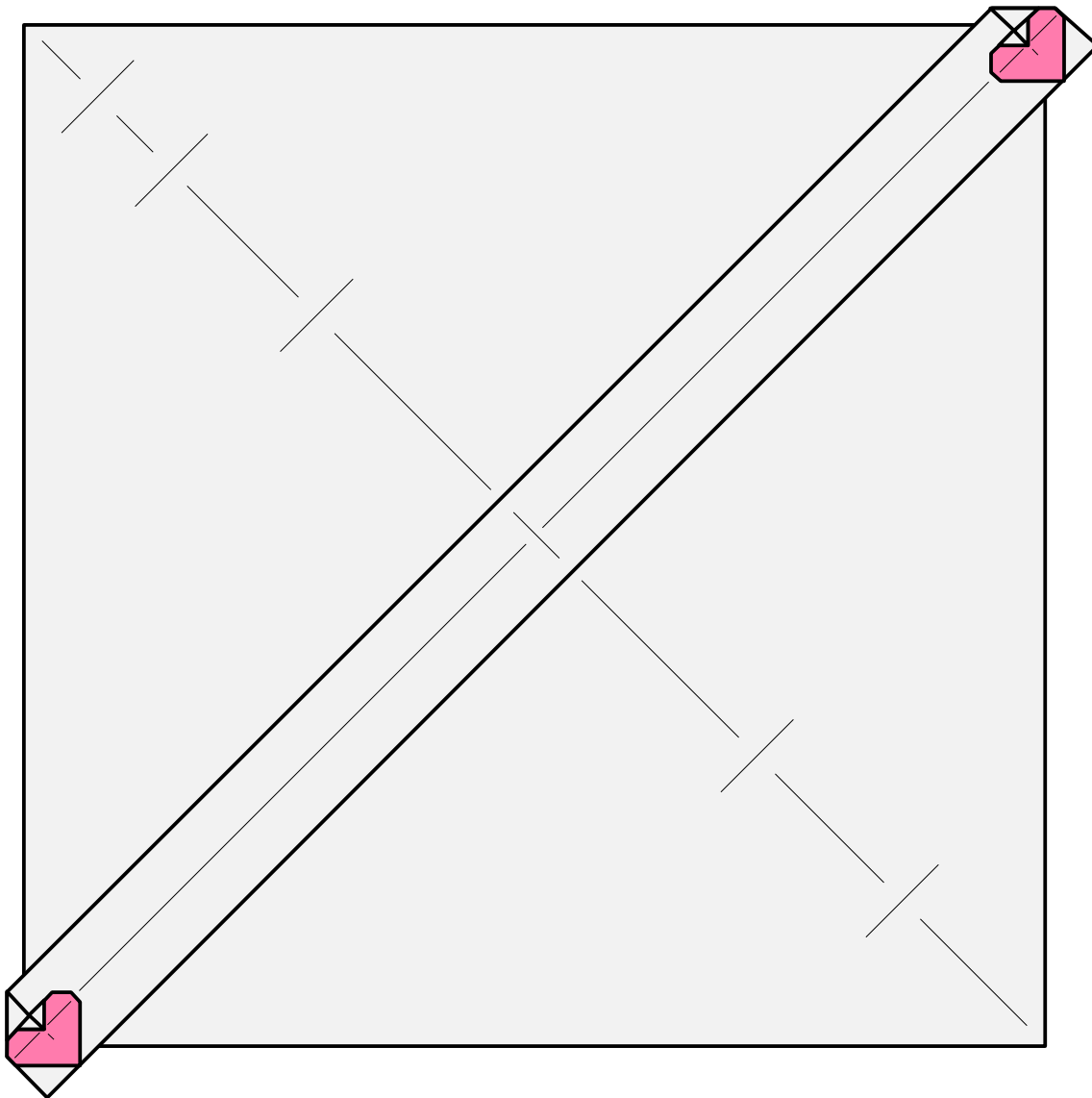


Two (2) tiny mountain folds to round the top and other side of the heart. Repeat on the other heart.

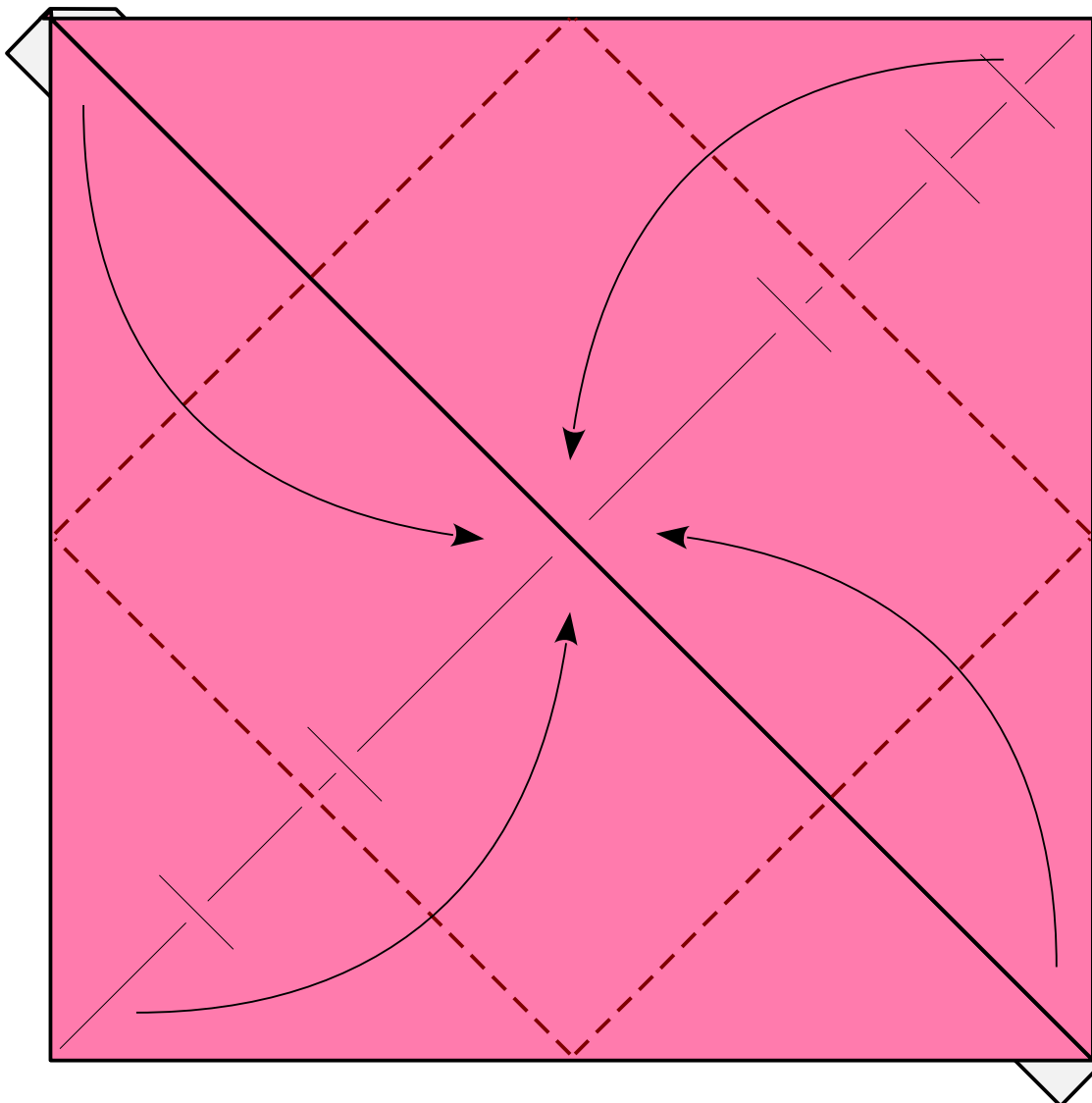


Return to full view.

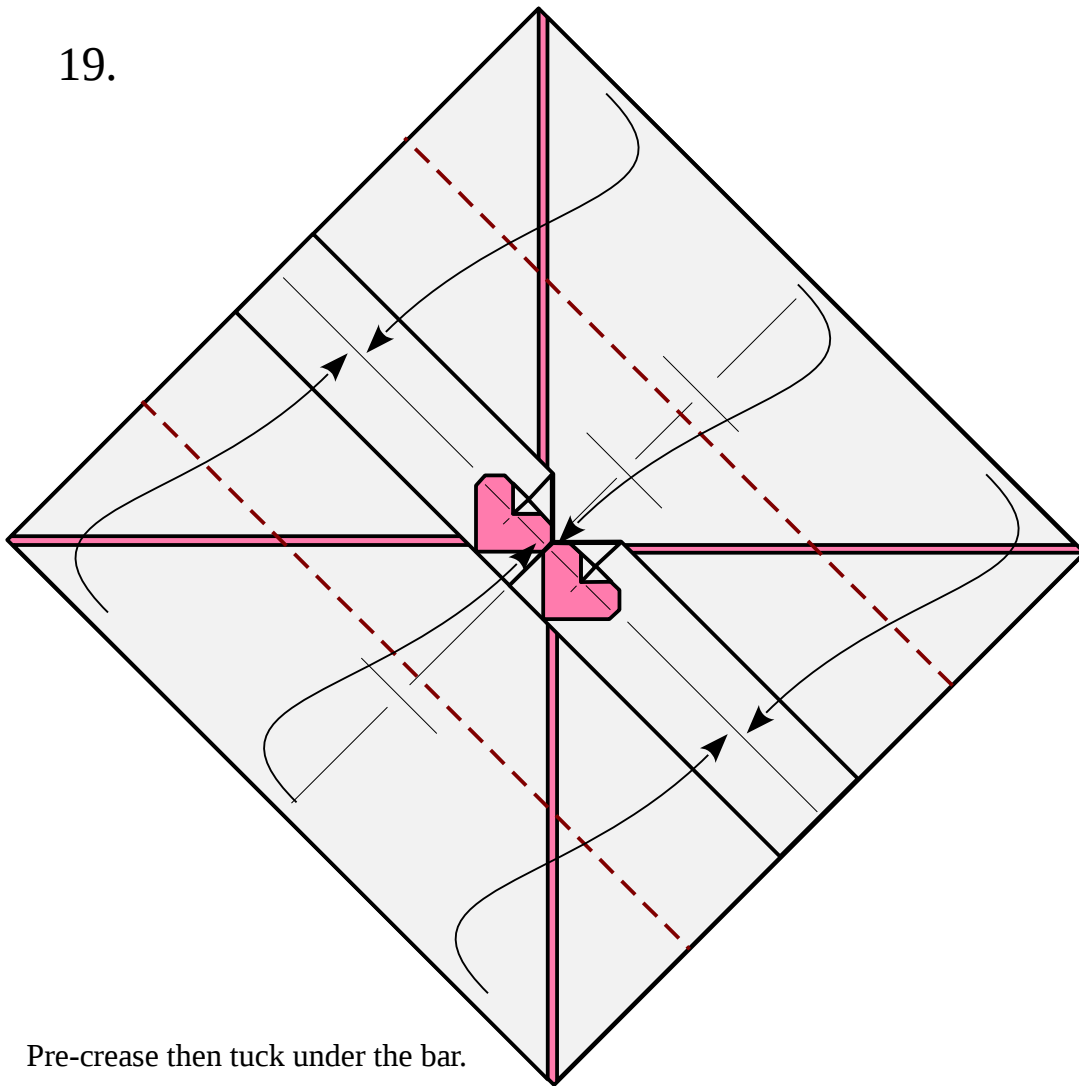

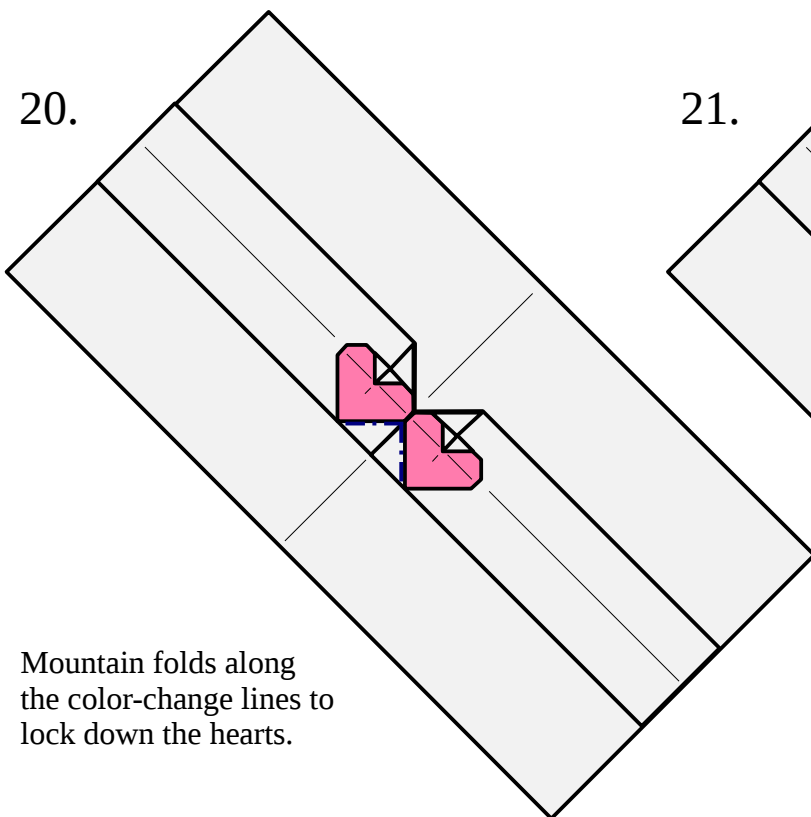
Blintz... well, almost. First, fold the simple corners to the center as in an ordinary blintz. For the corners with the hearts, bring the flat edge to the diagonal, lining up the diagonal crease through the end with the center. There will be a slight gap, but this only helps how the units fit together.

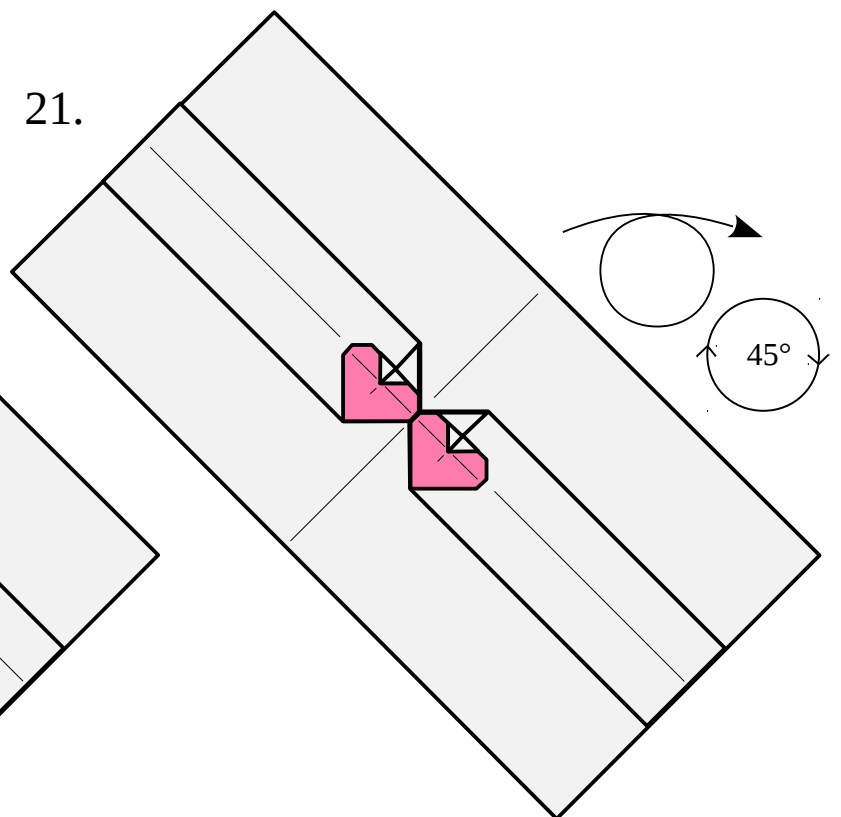
Pre-crease then tuck under the bar.

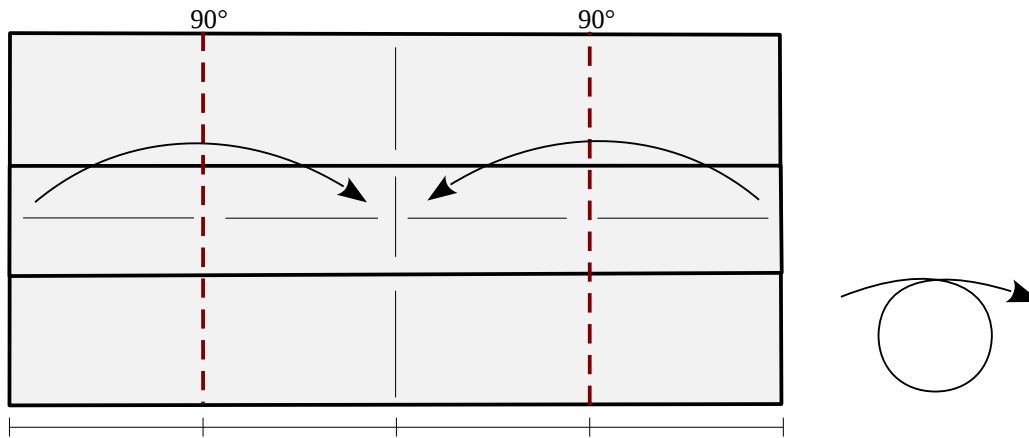


Mountain folds along the color-change lines to lock down the hearts.

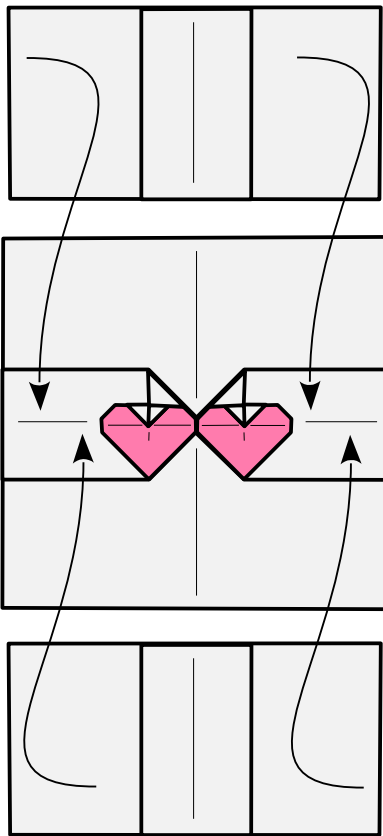

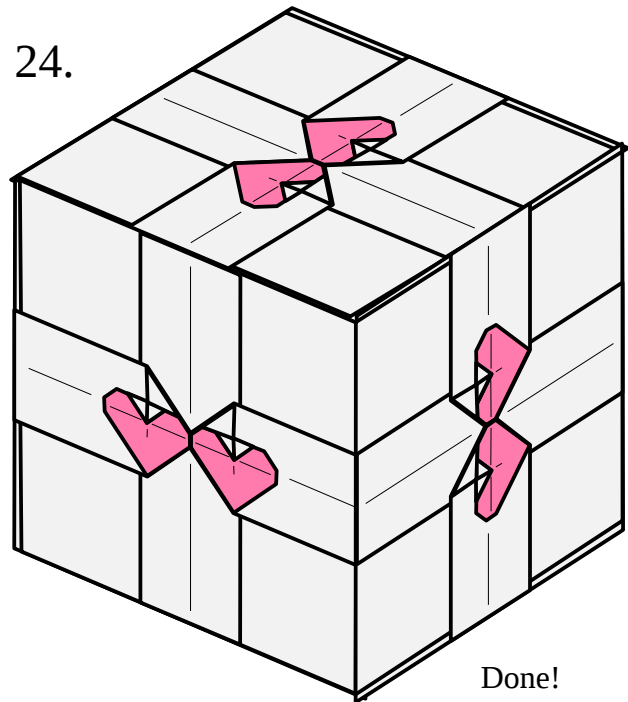
Crease, then stand the new tabs upright.
