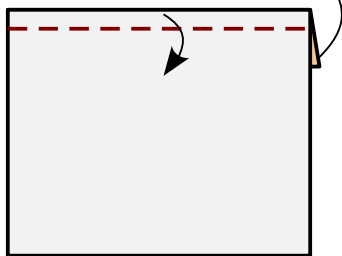
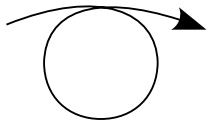


Perpendicular RAT fold.

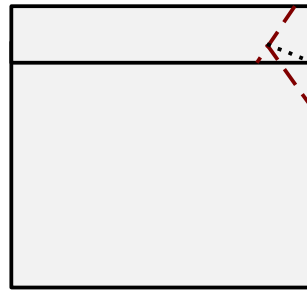

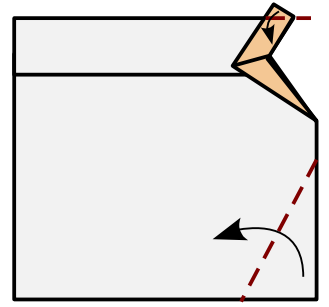
Reinstate the first fold. Let the flap flip forward.

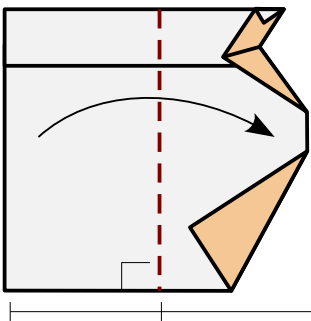
RAT v-squash.

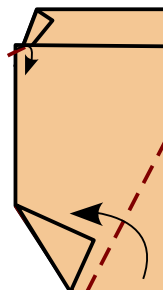

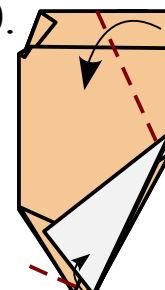
Two (2) RAT folds. For the smaller one, fold only the back layer.

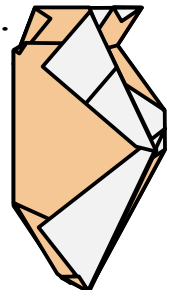
Two (2) RAT folds. For the larger one, fold only the top layer.

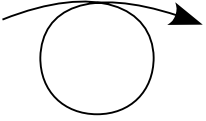

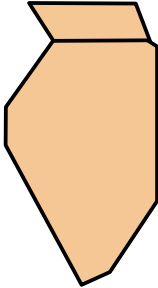
Two (2) RAT folds. For the larger one, fold only the top layers.
