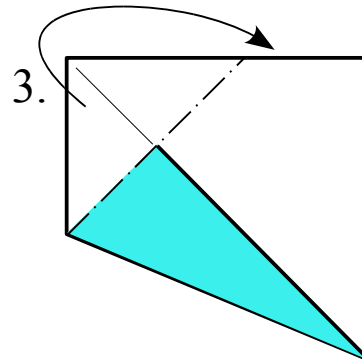
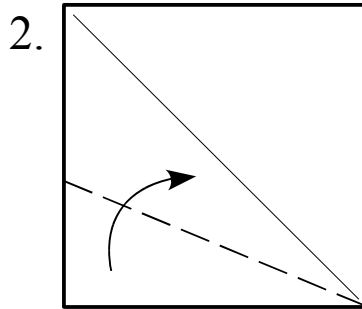
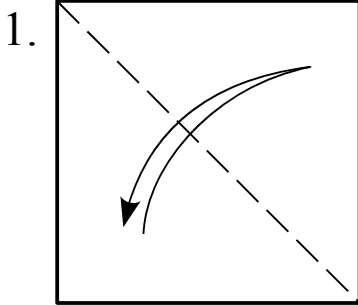


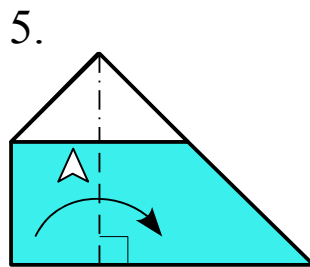
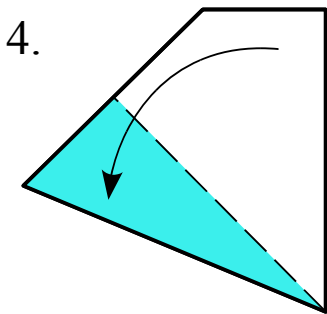
# Piebald Pinwheel

(5-15cm) squares of kami or duo.

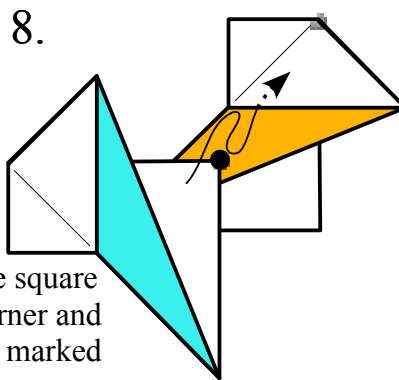
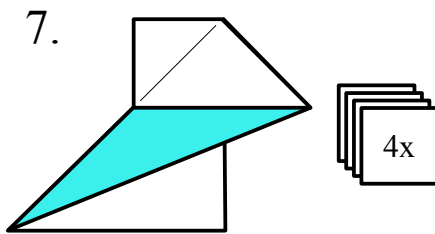
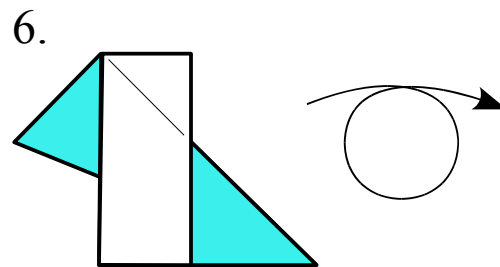

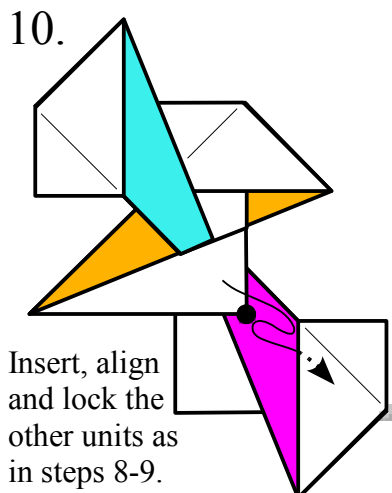
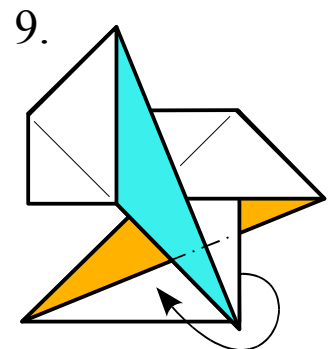
Mountain fold (behind) along the short edge of the triangle in front (and perpendicular to the diagonal crease line).



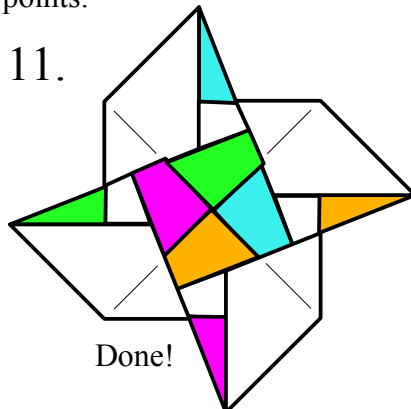
Squash open.



Insert the square white corner and align the marked points.



Insert, align and lock the other units as in steps 8-9.



Done!

Can spin on a pin! Put a straight pin through the center between the modules and anchor it in a pencil eraser or a dowel. A small bead makes a good washer behind the pinwheel.
