

Recommended Paper: 6" $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ square kami or paper-backed foil.

(hood) folds (RAT).


RAT folds to narrow the legs. (For a flat crab, leave longer unfolded tips


Form the claws by opening the tips from the inside and swiveling toward the body of the crab and starting a squash that will not lie flat. Include some of the point which was narrowed in step 6 for a 3D claw. (For flat, put the pivot point at the blunt corner.) Use somewhat different angle so that the claws don't overlap.


Small mountain folds will hold the claws in place.
