



Stop Sign and Lollipop



(75-150mm) paper-backed foil.







Collapse using pre-creases and allowing the layers in back without the diagonal crease to flip around. *No new creases.*




Mountain fold to the inside. Repeat behind.




Mountain fold to the inside. Repeat behind.




A foam paint brush!
Pick a path to something better – either a Stop Sign or a Lollipop.





Inside-reverse to form the top of the octagon.




Mountain folds to form the bottom of the octagon. Repeat behind.




Done!




Inside-reverse to round the top of the candy.
