Recommended Paper: Any small square (e.g. 1.5-6" (40-150mm) such as kami or duo.

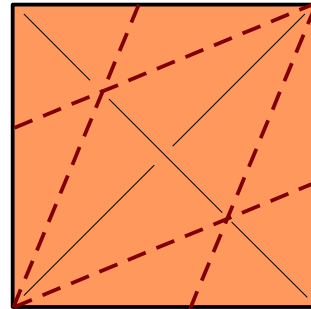

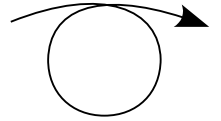

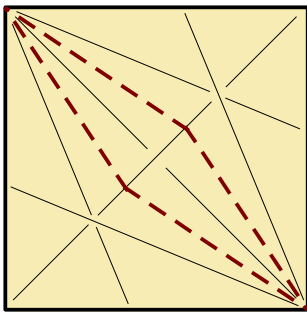

Pre-crease the kite folds.

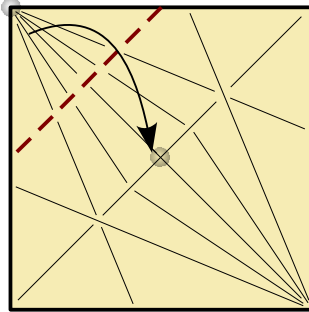

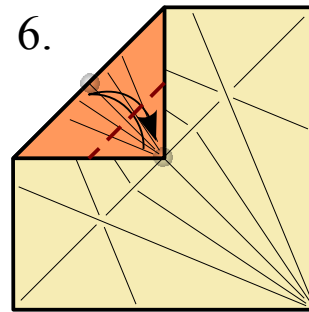

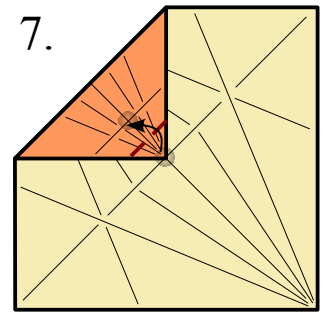
Fold to the center.

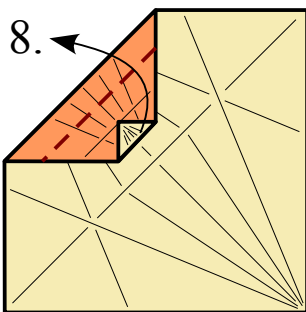

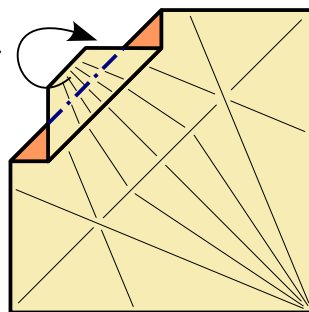

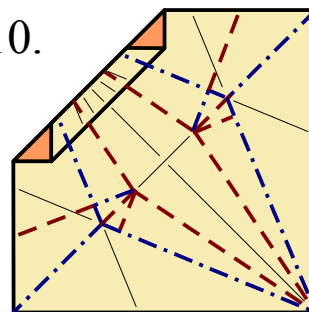
Fold the crease from step 6 to the edge.

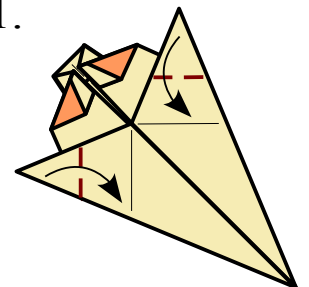
Mountain fold the crease from step 6.

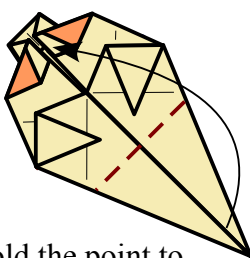
Collapse the "pleated rabbit-ears."

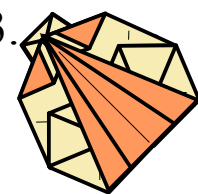
Hide the points! This isn't a winged pumpkin.

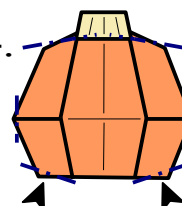
RAT fold the point to somewhere near the stem.

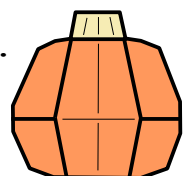
