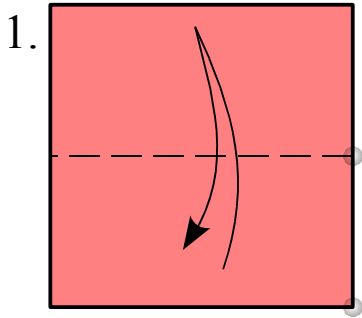


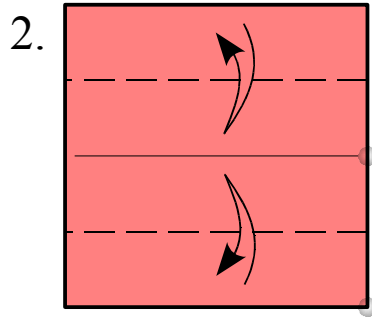
Heart Dish

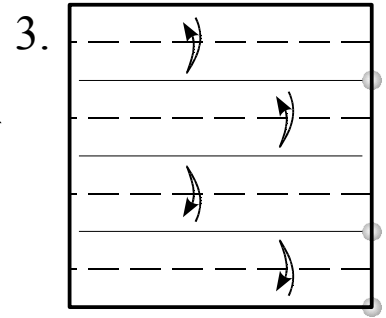
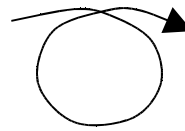
Recommended Paper: thin 3"-6" (75mm-150mm) square.



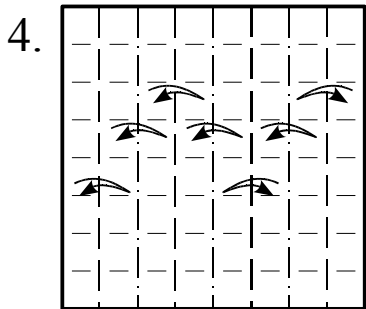
Half.



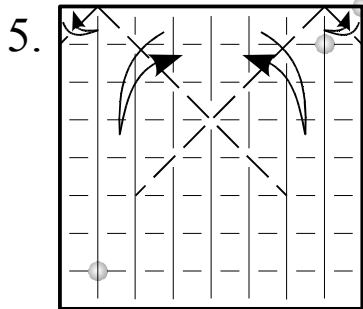

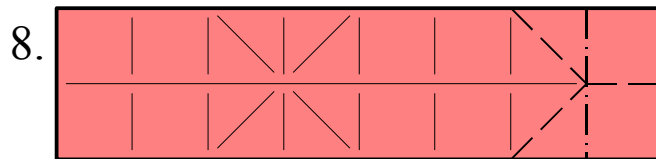
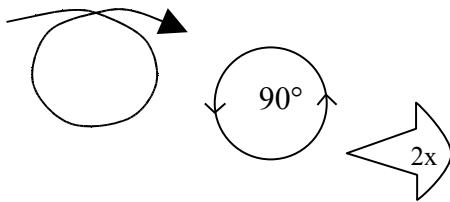
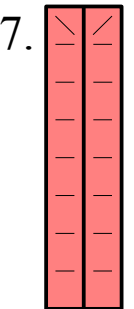
Repeat steps 1-3 crosswise.



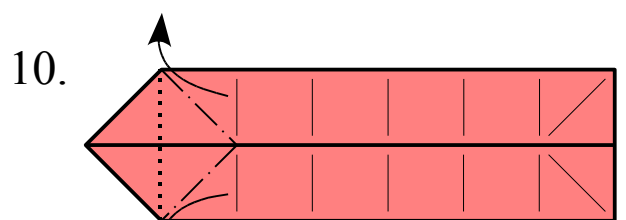
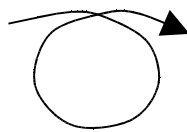
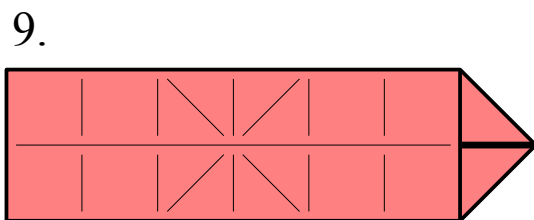
Pre-crease.



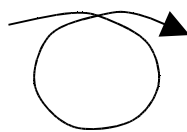
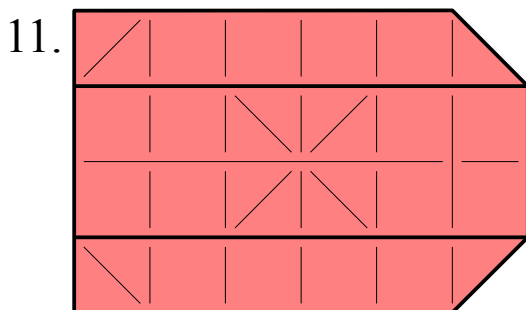
Re-pleat vertically, skipping the center.

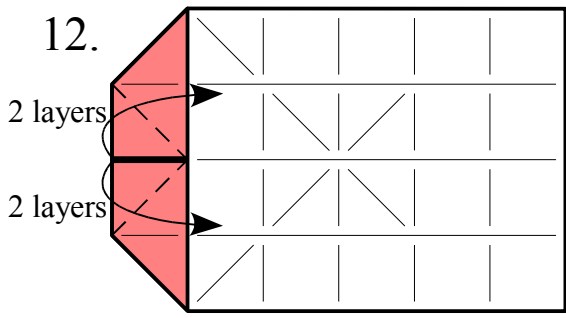


Rabbit-ear. Leave the ear upright. Model becomes 3D.

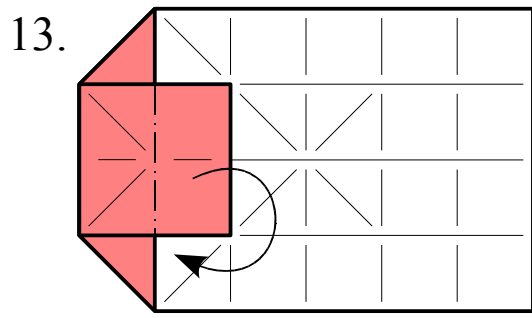


Shovel fold. (Pick up raw and folded edges on the center line and open, passing through a shape that looks like the scoop of a shovel.)

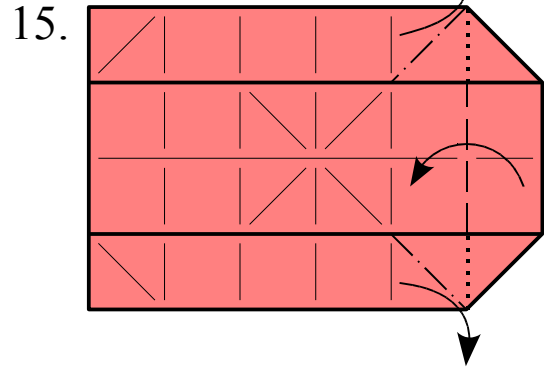
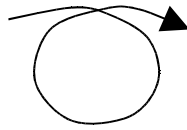
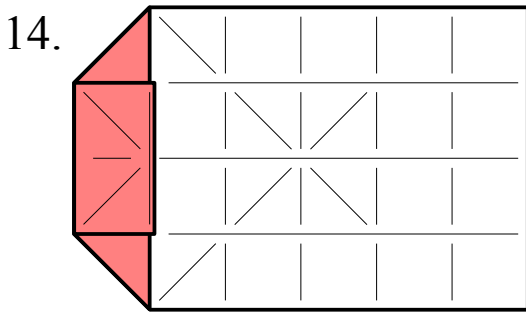




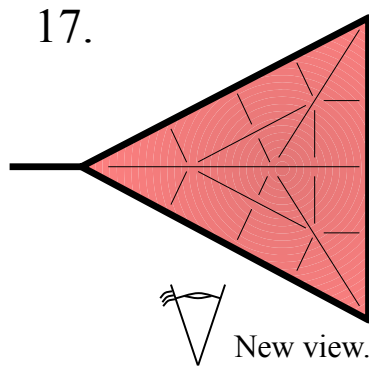
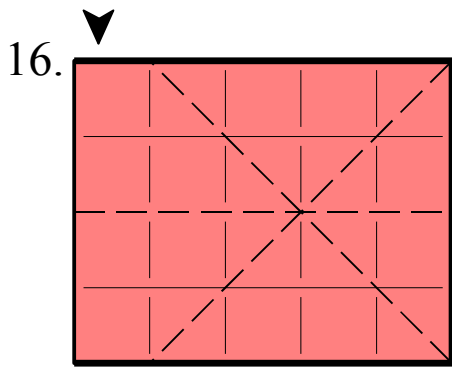
Open the middle of the upright rabbit-ear and lay it flat.



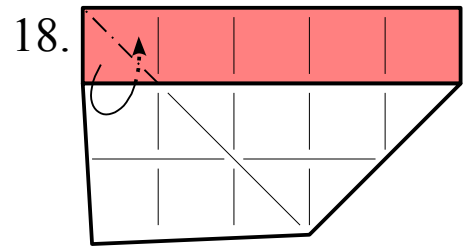
Mountain fold into the pocket.



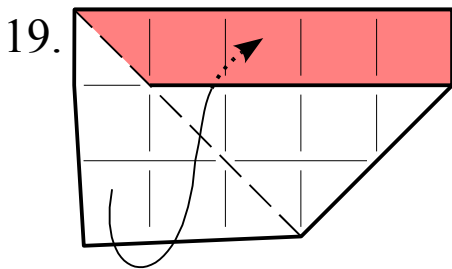
To stand up the three edges, stop a shovel fold midway.



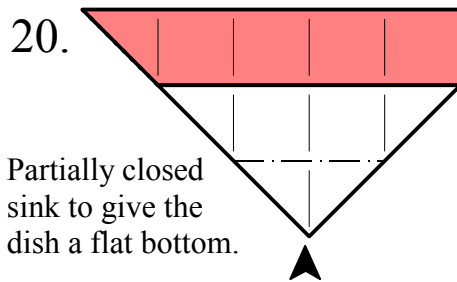
New view.



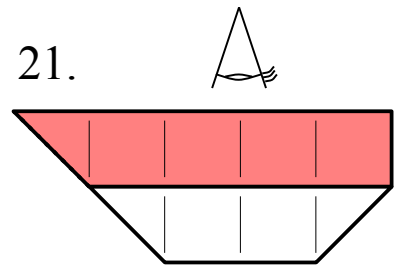
Tuck the dog-ear in using the pre-crease.



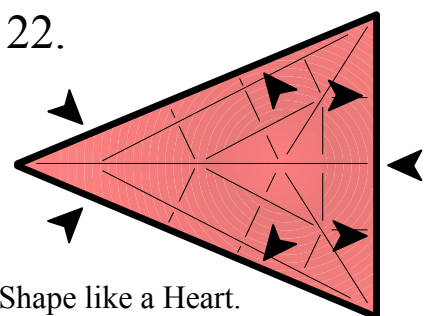
Tuck in all layers using the pre-crease.



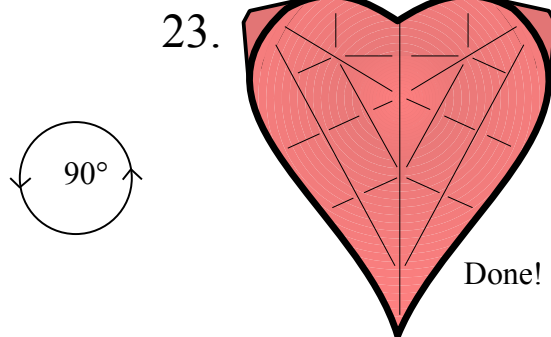
Partially closed sink to give the dish a flat bottom.
